WHITE

Viognier, Gimblett Gravels "Origin" Saint Clair 2019 £11.60

Hawke's Bay/New Zealand 13% *Vegan*

A blend of 96% Viognier & 4% Sauvignon Blanc, the wine has vivacious rich and creamy characters displaying aromas of passion-fruit, flavours of nectarine and gentle fragrant spice with an enticing and refreshing finish.

The name Saint Clair has become synonymous with quality and award-winning wines, the vineyard in the Gimblett Gravels region of Hawke's Bay has stony soils ideal for growing Viognier, the vines are trained using the Guyot system that reflects the ripeness of wines. Good match with spice or creamy dishes.

Chardonnay, 16 Stops 2020 £9.95

Adelaide/South Australia 13.5%

A blend of 97% Chardonnay & 3% Riesling. The wine is crisp and elegant with fresh citrus aromas complemented by white peach on the palate plus an attractive savoury edge, the natural acidity is perfectly balanced giving the wine good length on the finish.

The name 16 Stops comes from the number of stops on the railway line from Adelaide to the vineyard. The wines are made alongside Willunga 100 wines at their winery and benefit from the experience of excellent winemaker Mike Farmilo, but are sourced from multiple sites in South Australia, the majority coming from the Riverland district and Murray River.

RED

Shiraz, 16 Stops 2019 £9.95

Adelaide/South Australia 14% *Vegan*

This 100% Shiraz is a deep crimson-colour with aromas of spiced plums and vibrant dark fruit on the palate offering earthy notes of nutmeg and black pepper, the tannins are ripe and velvety giving the wine a glorious texture.

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
