NO UNINVITED TRADERS HERE Don't Ring – Don't Knock

Fed up of traders calling at your door? We can send you a free sticker to put on your door to stop them knocking.

Send us your address and we'll pop one in the post.

We've had reports of Suffolk residents receiving suspicious voicemails from 'HMRC' about lawsuits. This is a scam, HMRC will not contact you in this way. Do not comply!

Whilst for some it may seem like a clear scam, make sure you talk with Friends, Family and Neighbours who might not be so scam aware!

If you've received a suspicious call or voicemail from 'HMRC' about a lawsuit being brought against you, this is a scam. Do not comply.

Did you know that the a dairy cows daily minimum water intake can be as much as 52 litres and that horses need 38 - 45 litres depending on their size!

With temperatures continuing to rise, you must know how to care for livestock if you have even just one animal

You must take reasonable steps (such as preparing food and water) to plan for your animals' welfare in extreme weather. This should be part of your business planning when you know - or expect - livestock to be at risk during extreme weather

You should check on your animals often and take necessary action (such as providing more water) if needed

You should make sure livestock are protected from extreme weather and that food and water are available - you may need to cooperate with neighbours if supplies run short or access is difficult
